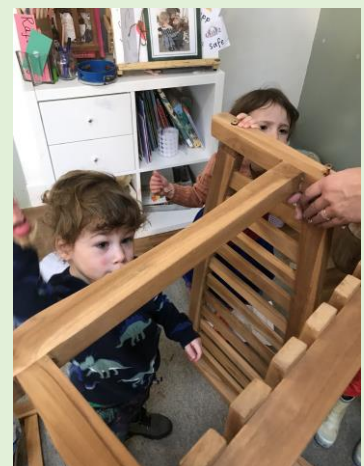


Learning Diary Week
